SWAN MISSIONS PROJECTS

KANTOLOMBA PROJECT

Through the generous support of sponsors and donors over the past two years Swan Missions has established programs to educate and provide food for children in Kantolomba Village in Zambia. During a mission awareness trip in 2009, staff and students from Swan Christian College were challenged to respond to the poverty stricken situation in Kantolomba Village where children in the community lacked the basic necessities of food and education. Many are orphaned through the HIV virus and struggle to find hope for the future with an unemployment rate of over 75 % and few job opportunities. Now through our school building and sponsor program over 100 children can look to a brighter future with the provision of regular meals and sound education. Funds raised through the 'Cycle for Change' will enable the building of two further classrooms at the Kantolomba School, providing space for at least 60 more children to be added to the programs. Our aim is to also introduce adult education to teach small business, health care and sustainable living practices. Through partnering with our Zambian brothers and sisters we can help them to break free from this vicious poverty cycle.

CAMBODIA

Hagar International and Awareness Cambodia are well established and effective mission agencies committed to empowering the people of Cambodia. The Cambodian nation is still recovering from the devastation imposed on them through the Khmer Rouge where over three million of their people were killed. This devastation has been compounded by an increase in HIV and a rise in the incidences of sex trafficking and child labour.

HAGAR INTERNATIONAL

Hagar International was established in 1994 and helps to rehabilitate women and children who have been rescued from backgrounds of violence, abuse and trafficking, equipping them with skills for the workforce to become strong, resilient and independent members of the community.

AWARENESS CAMBODIA

Awareness Cambodia, established in 1996, provides a safe and nurturing environment for many of Cambodia's orphans. Children under the care of Awareness Cambodia are supported to the end of their education and into the community as they transition through the aid organisation's three campuses: Sunshine House, House of Progress and Graduation House. Sound nutrition, good healthcare and a solid education which includes life skills training ensures that these young people are given every opportunity to achieve their potential.



FUNDRAISING BIKE RIDE

In 2010 a group of students and experienced adult riders rode from Albany to Perth to raise funds for Swan Missions Kantolomba Village School project. Generous support from the community resulted in the ride raising over \$30,000 toward providing water and sewerage for the school in Kantolomba as well as building a new kitchen.

This year the Cycle for Change has expanded to include more riders, a stronger support crew and doubled the distance to travel over 1,100 kilometers. With the prayers and support of everyone involved, the aim this year is to triple the amount raised to provide food and education to children in Kantolomba and Cambodia through the Kantolomba School Project, Awareness Cambodia and Hagar International.
